
Mission: To serve as the leading source of quality data about the nation's people, places and economy.

To conduct a census of population and housing and disseminate the results to the President, Congress, and the American people.

To apportion representation among states.



The 2020 Census Environment

The 2020 Census is being conducted in a rapidly changing environment, requiring a flexible design that takes advantages of new technologies and data sources while minimizing risk to ensure a high quality population count.



ESTABLISH WHERE TO COUNT Three modes: Internet, Telephone, Mail
 New adaptive design techniques enable more flexible and seamless self-response options – multiple languages, Non-ID

- Automation to efficiently manage and route on-the-ground field staff, as well as manage case assignment and the number of contact attempts
- Use of administrative records (i.e., data from other government agencies) to enable us to identify millions of vacant or nonexistent housing units





Tabulate Data and Release Census Results






WHERE TO

COUNT

- Deliver apportionment counts to the President and Congress by December 31, 2020
- Release counts for state redistricting by March 31, 2021
- Make it easier for the public to get 2020 census data and information; visualizations, improved search and data access functionality

 Assist 2020 Census operations and systems to adhere to appropriate (data) security policies and procedures.


IT Infrastructure

Ensure the integrity and availability of decennial infrastructure in the data centers, cloud, and field, inclusive of the mobile computing platform.


Applications



Shape your future: The 2020 Census



Why it is important to respond

Apportion representation among states as mandated by Article 1, Section 2 of the U.S. Constitution

Draw congressional and state legislative districts, school districts, and voting precincts

Distribute more than \$675 billion federal dollars annually to states

Inform federal, tribal, state, and local government planning decisions

Inform business and nonprofit organization decisions (e.g., where to locate, size of the market)
